**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 4, pollen value 4 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
