Tree types: standard trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: striking, singular | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, violet-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide, lobate | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** striking, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
