Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella, pleached

USE

Location: street, park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: raceme, striking, small, flower-scented, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, rich fruit yield, small, raceme, crabapple/ornamental apple | **Fruit colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched, central root
