TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, singular, small | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark red-violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, narrow | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** striking, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** dark red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
