TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: striking, singular, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** pink-red | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, crenate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, green | **Fruits:** striking, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red, violet | **Twigs:** bare
