Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies

Flowers: bowl-shaped, striking, pendulous, singular, big, scented | **Flower colour:** white, red | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, big | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, large | **Fruit colour:** pink-red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** extensive, coarse roots, fleshy roots
