Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting, shade-tolerant, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 0.6 - 0.9 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic (5.5 - 6.0) | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowering period: non-flowering | **Leaf colour:** green, bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, bipinnate | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** shallow, compact, slightly branched
