Location: park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
