Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, striking, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, small | **Fruit colour:** yellow, red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown
