TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, underside hairy, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, small, crabapple/ornamental apple, drupe | **Fruit colour:** yellow-green, green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
