TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, square, park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar, pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red-violet, violet | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits | **Fruit colour:** yellow, green | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
