Location: street, park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

Crown shape: narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
