Location: park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: catkins, discrete, singular | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, cordate, dissected | **Fruits:** edible, raspberry-like | **Fruit colour:** white, red, violet | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare
