Location: square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

Height: 1.25 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
