Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

Height: 0.75 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 0.35 - 0.4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.6 - 7.5) | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: spikes, panicle, standing | **Flower colour:** brown, red-brown | **Flowering period:** July - October | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, rough, grassy | **Autumn colour:** yellow, golden yellow, yellow-brown, brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Root system:** compact, slightly branched
