TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: in containers, roof garden, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 9 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 10A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** humans

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, discrete | **Flower colour:** white-yellow | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** grey, grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, leathery | **Fruits:** striking, edible, berry | **Fruit colour:** violet, green, black | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale grey | **Twigs:** bare
