TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** beehive, globe, egg-shaped, block, trapezium, bonsai

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** September - October | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, polished, prickly, dentate | **Fruits:** discrete, rarely fruits, drupe | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
