Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 7 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: hops, discrete, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** yellow-brown | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, hops | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
