Location: park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

Height: 0.15 - 0.3 m | **Width:** 30 - 45 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic (4.6 - 6.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees
