## **CHARACTERISTICS**

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | Crown structure: open | Height: 1 - 1.2 m | Width: 0.5 - 1 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5A - 10B

# **ASPECTS**

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 8.5) | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies

#### **PLANTKENMERKEN**

Flowers: spikes, striking, singular, small, scented | Flower colour: violet, blue | Flowering period: June - August | Leaf colour: grey-green, underside white-grey | Leaves: deciduous, lanceolate, small, slightly hairy, scented, laciniate, serrate | Autumn colour: brown | Fruits: no fruit | Bark colour: pale grey | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: grey | Twigs: hairy | Root system: moderately branched, coarse roots
