Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden

Height: 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4
