#### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, characteristic trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

#### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

#### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 9 - 22 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 7B

#### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

#### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** corymbose, discrete, scented | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, scented, curly | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** horizontal branches, thickly branched | **Root system:** deep, tap root
