Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 14 - 16 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 13B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

Flowers: panicle, discrete | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, opposite, polished, pinnate, composite | **Autumn colour:** orange, orange-red, scarlet, red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, edible, raceme | **Fruit colour:** red, blue | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, extensive, highly branched, central root
