TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, in containers, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 0.8 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds pink, buds red, green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, obovate, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
