TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, in containers, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, bell-shaped, striking, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
