**Location:** park, in containers, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

**Flowers:** panicle, bell-shaped, striking, standing, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery | **Fruits:** discrete | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
