Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1.5 - 4 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, standing, pendulous, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** evergreen, obovate, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** discrete | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
