Tree types: feathered trees, conifers, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 9 - 15 m | **Width:** 7 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** January - December | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
