TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: conifers, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover | **Topiary:** bowl

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: spikes, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow-red, red-brown | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, leaf scented | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
