Tree types: conifers, woodland planting stock | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
