TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: conifers, solitary shrubs | **Topiary:** beehive

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles, a bit prickly | **Fruits:** large, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** dark brown
