Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** bonsai

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, standing | **Flower colour:** dark red | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** grey-blue, buds pale green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles, leaf scented | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** violet-grey | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow, brown | **Twigs:** bare
