Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary:** bonsai

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** pale yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
