USE

Location: park, large garden, countryside | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
