Tree types: standard trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** globe

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7B - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals, humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** brown, bronze | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow, brown | **Twigs:** bare
