TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles, scented | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** yellow, orange, brown | **Twigs:** bare
