TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, climate trees, characteristic trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** block, multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** bonsai

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, windbreak, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, standing, small | **Flower colour:** pale yellow, violet | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** blue-green, buds grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, short needles, leaf scented | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown, green | **Bark colour:** orange, brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, finely branched | **Root system:** deep, shallow, coarse roots, tap root
