USE

Location: park, large garden, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 6 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** yellow-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** small, cones | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** orange, red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** bare
