Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees | **Topiary on stem:** globe, roof-trained, pollard

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 10 m | **Width:** 3 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** green, grey | **Twigs:** bare
