TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 15 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: heads, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, underside hairy, dissected, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, thorned, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
