**Tree types:** standard trees, woodland planting stock

### USE

**Location:** avenue, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 25 - 30 m | **Width:** 15 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** catkins | **Flower colour:** red, green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, deltoid, matt polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** capsule, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
