ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: catkins, discrete | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, deltoid, matt polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** capsule, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
