Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.7 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: striking, singular, small | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** June - October | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, small, underside hairy, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
