Location: park, large garden, countryside

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 7B

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline
