Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting

Height: 0.25 - 0.9 m | **Width:** 0.6 - 0.8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic (5.8 - 6.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, pendulous | **Flower colour:** white, green | **Flowering period:** May - July | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, composite | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** berry | **Fruit colour:** blue, blue-black, black | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** central root
