### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, characteristic trees

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide weeping | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 2A - 7B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** catkins, striking, pendulous | **Flower colour:** pale grey, silver | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, grey-green, underside grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, orbicular, ovate, dentate, undulate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-green | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-green | **Twigs:** bare, zigzagging, horizontal branches, pendulous, thickly branched | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, central root, root suckers, roots push up surface,
