Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: raceme, half filled, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** bare
