Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, half filled, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
