Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees | **Topiary on stem**: multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary**: espalier

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden | Pavement: none | Planting concepts: food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 5 - 8 m | Width: 5 - 8 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness

Flowers: striking, singular, scented | Flower colour: white | Flowering period: April - April | Leaf colour: green | Leaves: deciduous, ovoid | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: striking, edible, plum | Fruit colour: yellow-orange | Bark colour: red-brown | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: red-brown | Twigs: bare
