Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, small, scented | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, dentate | **Autumn colour:** red-brown | **Fruits:** small, plum | **Fruit colour:** yellow, red | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** slightly thorned
